Covid safety in Nursery

Although national lockdown restrictions are easing we are continuing to keep our children and staff safe, and are minimising risk of transmission by following our usual measures. We remind you to keep your child away from school for 48 hours if their temperature is high.

We ask you to continue wearing masks when on the school grounds and also keep a 2m distance when waiting for your children to enter, or leave nursery.

Suncream

Just a little reminder as the weather gets warmer, your child should have sun cream applied before coming to nursery.

If you feel your child will need more sun cream



applying throughout the session, we will require you to bring a new bottle of cream into nursery. This should be labelled clearly with your child's name.

Would you also indicate via Tapestry that you give consent

for staff to apply sun cream in your absence.

WE NEED YOUR HELP

As lockdown restrictions ease, we will be looking for volunteers to help us with the maintenance of our grounds, including our gardens and the forest (looking after our bog garden, laying woodchip etc).
