### **½ Day Forest School Taster Session 1**

#### **Course Leader – L3 Forest School Trained Leader**

Adult only session where you will explore the principles of forest school and the benefits to children of outdoor investigation. You will experience the delivery of a forest school session, health and safety considerations and explore a range of different activities. Links to research and suggested reading will be provided.

**½ Day Forest School Taster Session 2**

**Course Leader – L3 Forest School Trained Leader**

An opportunity to take part in a forest school session with children – putting principles from session 1 into practice. Support and engage with children during a forest school session. *Prior to attendance it is recommended that delegates also attend session 1*

**SEND – School/Setting Visits, Advice and Classroom Support**  
**Course Leader – ASD/SEMH Lead teacher**

We can visit your school/setting and provide personalised advice and guidance to staff. This could be for example, how to meet the needs of an individual pupil, assessment and support to write personal plans, practitioner modelling, adapting routines and/or the learning environment to achieve the best outcomes how to set up a visual timetable, how to differentiate activities, how to assess a pupil in a specific area. They can also provide in-lesson support for the pupil and school staff if required.

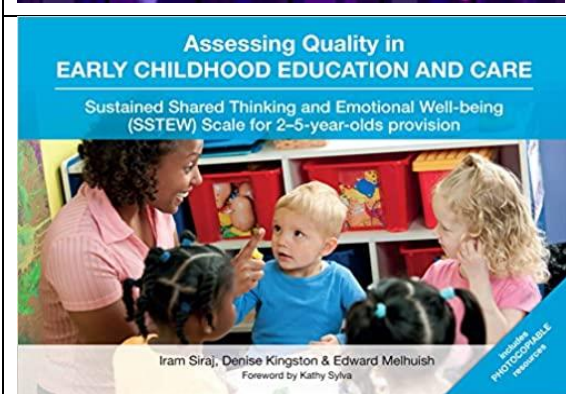
Full Day Course




**Mainstream - Sustained Shared Thinking and Emotional Wellbeing (SSTEWS)**

**Audit Leader – Fully trained SSTEWS auditor, EY SLE and HT**

Half Day Audit, detailed report and feedback meeting.

A half day setting audit focusing on the quality of provision and practice. Settings will then receive a report and a follow up meeting with senior leaders to discuss the audit results and next steps to improve practice and provision.
