At Sandy Lane Nursery and Forest School, we believe good attendance is essential if children are to be settled and take full advantage of the learning and development opportunities available to them at school. Although we recognise that attending nursery is not statutory, we hope to work with parents and carers to develop good habits of punctuality and attendance in children.

Children learn and develop most between the ages of birth to five years - developing good habits now will benefit them through their entire school life and beyond. Consistency and routine is also very important for young children and greatly benefits their wellbeing. **Good attendance results in happy, settled children who make good progress**
