If a Home visit took place prior to your child attending for their first visit at nursery, did you find this useful? In what ways do you think it helped both you and your child?

Yes definitely, it's a fab idea to get S used to his teachers

It helped us a lot as we were made aware of routine and what support and help is available for us as parents, and G if we needed it. We were asked about G so that I felt as though teaching assistants were aware of G's needs before he stated.

It was really nice to meet Jamie, she was very welcoming and gave us lots of information about the nursery and A felt comfortable being left alone on her first visit with her.

It was very useful as I got to meet some of his teachers and learn more about the nursery which helped me feel a lot happier knowing he was going to be well looked after and learn and explore things he couldn't at home they were lovely and made us all feel at ease with the transition to nursery they also took the time to learn more about B's needs and took note on what can help him get through his nursery sessions

Yes was a nice visit

Yes, it allowed us as parents to get to know staff in the room and it allowed them to see O in his usual environment.

We got to meet the staff and ask any questions. Found it very helpful

Very useful. I was able to see how C responded to Jamie and it gave C a familiar face on her first day.

We found the home visit useful however we pretty much knew everything from L and L transitioning to Sandy Lane

Very useful. Jamie was fab she gave us lots of info about nursery which was helpful for us to explain to Lottie what nursery would be like. She also took time to get to know L and find out things about her to help her transition.

Yes, I had more understanding of what H's day would be like and what support he will be getting

It was lovely to meet the staff who were going to be taking care of my child and it was a nice way for him to meet them before starting Nursery! Very helpful!

It was nice to meet his teacher

Yes it was useful, it helped to introduce T to some of the staff and it was useful for them to see how he responded to them.

Not particularly. We tried to explain to a member of staff about E-S biting and she was very dismissive about our concerns (Parents were very anxious that their 2 year old may bite other children as she does her older sibling at home. Following further discussion with parents they appreciate that this can be usual behaviour for some children of this age with limited communication skills)

Yes I found it helpful as me and H got to meet H's teacher and he seemed really at ease when we had a chat

It was useful as I could give information about her needs before she started and she got to meet some of the staff in a familiar environment

Yes, I got to ask questions and meet the staff. Made me feel at ease

Yes. It gave us an idea what child need to take to nursery and gave us a picture about activities he will be doing.

Everybody made him feel welcome

G has settled extremely well and that is down to the time that was taken by teaching assistants to get to know him

All the staff have been amazing and A loves coming to nursery

They allowed us to bring in his fidget toys so he had them if he needs them and they listened to my worries and concerns they were so reassuring and made it a much easier experience for me and B

I felt comfortable with the staff member's opinions on how he was getting on and the strategies they used to help him regulate.

Staff were very friendly and welcoming. R loves them. Teachers were very helpful in answering my questions

Yes. Jamie has gone out of her way to be available to C to make her feel safe at nursery.

Yes T was much supported

Yes great all around.

Definitely. Nothing has been too much trouble, from changing transition dates to suit G and tailoring his transition to best meet his needs - coming to the foyer to walk him in as he was getting upset me being there.

Staff have a warm friendly approach.

Fab! L loves nursery and learning. Her learning, socialising and communication has carried on going from strength to strength thanks to nursery.

His transition went really well

I believe that M has adapted very well as well as received very good support from your side

(In addition to the key worker sheet and room staff Tapestry post, parents get the opportunity to meet all staff during their child's initial visit to nursery. For organisational reasons we aren't able to arrange for the full room team to attend home visits)
